Dear Valued Texas Rangers Vendors and Suppliers:

As you may have heard, the Texas Rangers Baseball Club has taken a bold step to complete the sale of the Club to Rangers Baseball Express, a local investor group led by Chuck Greenberg and me. This morning, to implement our plan and complete the sale, Texas Rangers Baseball Partners, the current owner of the Rangers, initiated a voluntary "prepackaged" Chapter 11 proceeding that has the support of Major League Baseball. The purpose of the filing is to transfer ownership of the Rangers to Rangers Baseball Express. The attached press release describes our plans in more detail.

This plan was previously negotiated and agreed to by the current Rangers owner and the new ownership group. Upon approval by the Bankruptcy Court, the plan will pay all creditors in full, including 100% of the Rangers' debt to the creditors. We expect to move through the legal process expeditiously – and most likely complete it and the sale by mid-summer.

During this time, we will continue our normal day-to-day business operations and management of the Club. We expect to pay vendors and suppliers in full under normal terms for all goods and services provided after the filing date. We have requested the Court's permission to pay suppliers for goods and services provided before the filing date in the ordinary course of business. Additionally, under the terms of the proposed plan of reorganization, which is subject to court approval, all claims of suppliers and vendors are to be paid in full or "unimpaired."

Furthermore, MLB has agreed to provide the Rangers with a new credit facility to ensure that the Club continues to meet all of its obligations while the sale is being completed.

Your role in our business is critical, and we look forward to strengthening our relationship with you. We will make every effort to keep you informed of significant developments.
